Sheringham Ramblers Away Day to Snape Maltings and Aldeburgh Sunday 28th September 2025

Our Away Day adventure was a trip to Snape Maltings to walk the Sailor's Path to Aldeburgh in Suffolk, a 6-mile walk. On arrival at Snape Maltings, our best laid plans were thwarted by the Aldeburgh Food Festival in full swing, denying us access to the site unless we paid the entry fee. Not a good start. After much pleading with, and resistance from the officious lady on the gate, we were escorted, by a sympathetic official, to the toilets. So, we were then ready to begin our walk. The first section crossed over the River Auld and then ran alongside it. The weather was kind, despite the forecast, allowing us to enjoy the stunning scenery across the riverbank, and the birds feeding on the exposed sand banks.

After a while, we left the riverside to enter the beautiful Black Heath Woods; then on past Hazelwood Marshes to reach Aldeburgh. There we stopped to view Benjamin Britton's and Peter Pear's home, The Red House, now open to visitors.

At the end, we enjoyed the walk alongside the shingle beach, past the stalls selling delicious shellfish, smoked and fresh fish, to finish at the ancient Moot Hall. Plenty of time was left to enjoy Aldeburgh, sample the seafood or browse the shops before departing home. All agreed it was a most enjoyable day.

Legstretchers is the long distance walking group of Norfolk Ramblers, aimed to offer members of the various county's groups a chance to get together for longer, challenging but fun walks. Our walks are usually 17+ miles in length. Last summer we also had a couple of 20+ mile walks to take advantage of the longer days. Walks are varied around the county.
